Joanna Burn: For her caring nature and digging deeper into her learning.

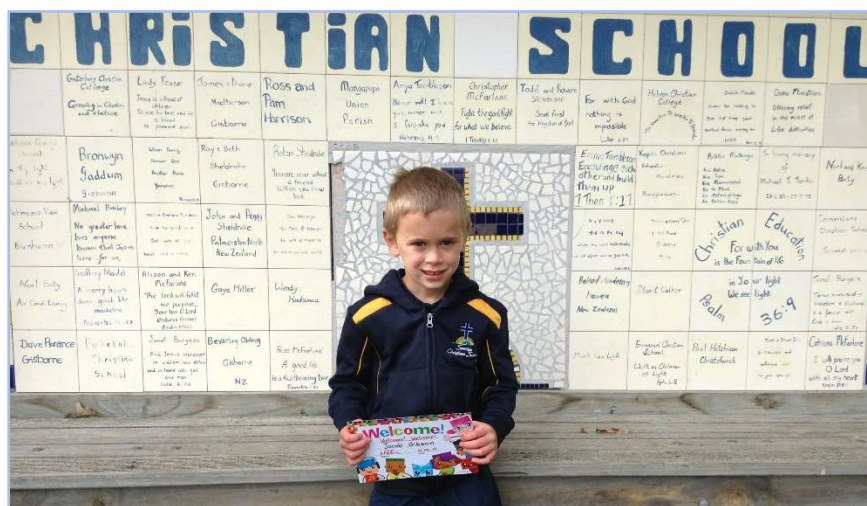
