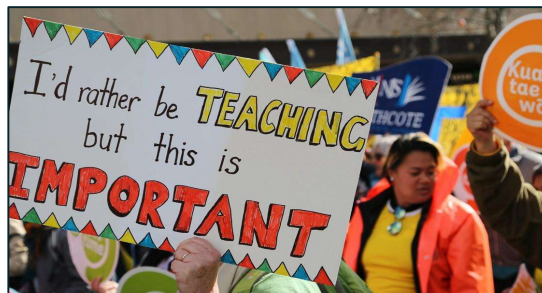


# Sonrise Christian School NEWSLETTER
