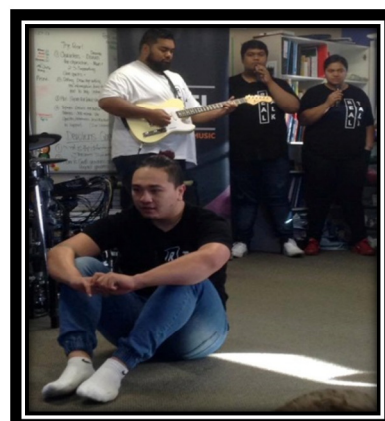
GENERAL INFORMATION
